The announcement of the recent closure of the Hughes Aircraft Company acquisition by Raytheon and the business growth strategy that I outlined at last October's "All Hands" meeting have prompted a reorganization of the Falls Church operation. Effective today, we will restructure our operations along the functional lines of a traditional matrix-managed organization. We will manage the acquisition of business and program performance through three consolidated business areas. The business areas have integrated marketing responsibilities, and I have eliminated the separate Business Development department. The leadership assignments are depicted on the enclosed organization chart.

I have created the position of Assistant to the General Manager and have assigned Larry Cecchini to serve in this position. In essence, Larry will serve as my "chief of staff" and will be responsible for bringing consistency to our program management and new business acquisition processes. He will also be responsible for administering enterprise-wide business changes that will come from the new Raytheon company.

I am very pleased to announce the promotions and assignments of Kerry Rowe as Engineering Director and John Monahan as Operations Director. They will serve in their functional management capacities as coequals to the business area leaders and the other members of the senior staff. Please join me in congratulating Kerry and John, and in welcoming them to their new responsibilities.

I have also restructured the Information Systems Group along functional and program management lines. Within ISG, I have established a Y2K product area under Dean Sims' leadership and an Advance Systems area under John Carroll's direction, both focused on acquiring and managing new business. Carl O'Riley will continue to lead our Department of Education programs, which are the flywheel of ISG operations. Max Mansur has been reassigned as Engineering Manager for ISG and will receive functional guidance from Kerry Rowe.


The organizational changes being implemented are designed to create greater opportunity for our people, flexibility in assignments, commonality of process among programs, and increased skill development. But, like anything else, this change will have its challenges. Your leadership team has allowed for a period of transition to make sure we complete our 1997 administrative actions before we become too focused on the new structure. I expect to receive everyone's cooperation during the transition, and further, I expect you to continue treating each other with dignity, courtesy, and respect. Just keep in mind that the vast majority of you will be doing exactly the same thing, in the same place, and for the same supervisor tomorrow as you are today.

Finally, let's not lose sight of our customers and commitments during this changeover. We must continue to meet our business obligations while we implement this change. I am counting on each of you to continue doing your job during this transition.


